

- 1st Overall (forfeits the Class Award)
- 1st in Class (if 3 or more starters)
- 2nd in Class (if 5 or more starters)
- 3rd in Class (if 8 or more starters)

9. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations. Entries must be made on the official entry form, accompanied by the appropriate fee and received by Friday 26th May.

The fee for entries received by that date is £25 Classes 1-3. Class 4 £15

11. The maximum entry for the Meeting, including reserves, is 50. The minimum is 15. Should the above minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the Meeting, or amalgamate classes as necessary.

12. Competitors are reminded of noise limit regulations

13. Timing will be by electronic timing equipment
The starting signal will be verbal.
The order of attempting tests will be numerical.

14. Penalties will be as follows as per MSA Yearbook Table M.7:-

- A. Striking pylons/cones - 5 seconds.
- B. Not performing a test correctly - FAIL (fastest time in class + 20 seconds).
- C. Lines A maximum penalty will be applied if a competitor crosses with both leading wheels a marked test line in the wrong direction, out of the prescribed sequence or too many/few times, otherwise competitors may correct their mistakes by returning to the point where they deviated from the test diagram, unless otherwise stated in the SRs.

Failure to attempt to cross a line = Fail.

A Fail is deemed to be fastest in that class plus 20 seconds. One entrant in a class and a test is failed, that entrant must repeat the test and 20 seconds including any penalties will be added to the time.
There will be a Maximum Time for each test which will be the fastest time in class plus 20 seconds.

15. Test diagrams will be available on ADC and ANICC websites. Copies will be distributed at signing on

20. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following which are modified:-
M.6. Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height.

21. Timing will start on front wheels crossing the start-line from a rolling start and finishing when front wheels

cross the stop-line, not when the car stops.

22. A competitor who completes at least 50% of the tests shall be given Maximum Times for the remaining tests and will qualify as a finisher.

23. A competitor is responsible for the accuracy of the times written on his Time-Card and should retain the card in good condition throughout the event. Time-Cards must be returned to the results officials within 15 minutes of the final competitor completing the final test.

24. Competitors must have passed scrutiny and signed on **BEFORE** driving cars on venue!!!
